

How To Use

E-Z SHAPE SPARKLE BODY

Dress your fly with hair, feathers, and flash materials as usual. Shake the bottle before using. Squeeze the bottle slowly to apply the 'SPARKLE BODY and use the tip of the bottle to help create the desired shape. A rotary vise is helpful during application. Coat any part of the fly that you wish with E-Z SHAPE SPARKLE BODY. Keep the bottle tightly capped when not in use.

Final shaping can be done while the 'SPARKLE BODY is still wet by using only the very tip of a bodkin or other fine tool. Work with a light touch – don't try to reshape the surface, but simply drag a small amount of the 'SPARKLE BODY from a high spot to a low one, or vice versa. Make any necessary adjustments to the 'Sparkle Body within 10 minutes of application, then allow to dry undisturbed. As the 'Sparkle Body dries, it will shrink slightly, and the finished body shape will become smooth and consistent.

Add any desired highlights such as eyes, gill markings, etc., then let dry. E-Z SHAPE SPARKLE BODY dries to the touch in a couple of hours. Your flies will be ready to fish the next day!

*Apply a coat of 'SPARKLE BODY instead of tinsel over a simple thread base on a streamer pattern, to make a sparkling baitfish body.

*Use E-Z SHAPE SPARKLE BODY in place of epoxy to coat the head of a deceiver. Use the Pure colors to create two-tone eyes on deceivers and other streamer patterns.

*Coat foam slider and popper heads by using a brush to apply a thin coat of E-Z SHAPE SPARKLE BODY! Clean your brush with soap and water.

*Saltwater and bass flies are E-Z to coat with 'SPARKLE BODY. Oddly shaped flies such as squid and crab patterns may require an underbody made of yarn or spun deer hair, trimmed to the appropriate shape.

*E-Z Shape Sparkle Body can be thinned very slightly with water if necessary (just a drop or two in the bottle is all that's needed)! This is an especially useful technique if you wish to make small eyes with our "Pure" colors.

*For beautiful freshwater flies, use the 'SPARKLE BODY as head cement to make an attractive, glossy streamer head, or coat the wingcase of a nymph to make a "flashback" style fly. Scud, shrimp, larvae, and "epoxy back" patterns are E-Z with 'SPARKLE BODY.
